Acetaminophen

You may give your child Acetaminophen (Tylenol[®], Tempra[®], Pediacare Fever Reducer[®]) if your child is uncomfortable with a fever. Use the acetaminophen dosing chart below. Use your child's weight to select the dose; if you don't know the weight, then use the dose appropriate for the child's age.

You may repeat the dose of acetaminophen every 4-6 hours. Do not use it more than 5 times in 24 hours.

When giving the infant's or children's suspension, shake well before using.

Make certain that you always check the concentration (strength) of the acetaminophen product.
